Physical Revaluation in 2015

A revaluation of property within the Town of Elba is scheduled to be completed for the 2015 assessment year to be in compliance with state laws. Employees of L. E. Gardiner Assessment Service, LLC will be stopping by during the day to view the exterior of all buildings within the Town and measure any new buildings. All employees will have a picture ID that will identify them as an employee of L. E. Gardiner Assessment Service, LLC. If someone is home, the assessor may request permission to view the interior. If it is not a convenient time or if no one is home, a drop card will be left notifying you that we stopped by and a postcard will be mailed for an appointment at a later date. It will take several months to complete all of the appointments.

DID YOU RECEIVE YOUR LOTTERY & GAMING CREDIT??

If you do not have a Lottery & Gaming credit on your tax bill you may still be eligible.

To Qualify: You must own a home in Wisconsin.

Your home must have been occupied as a **PRIMARY** resident on January 1, 2014.

a. A primary residence is the home in which a property owner lives for

than six months of the year.

b. If temporarily away, a primary residence is the home to which the owner returns.

If you feel you qualify for the credit, and there is not a lottery credit on your tax bill, please plan to come to the Town Hall on one of the collec-
