December payments must be postmarked by December 31, 2020 to be considered timely.

Payments must be postmarked by January 31, 2021.

2nd Installment Payments are payable to: Dodge County Treas.

Include stubs from parcels and self-addressed STAMPED envelope.

Collecting Tax Payments

Farmers & Merchants Union Bank

You may pay your tax bills at both FMUB locations in Columbus, during regular business hours.

*Make sure to bring your tax stubs for each parcel to ensure proper payment.

*Please note, if you have an escrow or other check that in greater than the balance of your tax bill, I will mail you your refund check after the next board meeting. The bank will NOT be issuing refunds.

Town Hall Collections

There will be no in person tax collecting at the Town Hall this year due to COVID-19. You may place your payments in the drop box at the Town Hall anytime, they are collected daily. If you would like to receipt, please include an addressed envelope. Otherwise, in person payments are accepted at Farmers & Merchants Bank in Columbus.

Sign up for Land Notification!

What is Land Notification? The Land Notification system gives you the ability to monitor a name or a specific parcel of land for property real estate activity. You can create one or more alerts that are triggered when real estate records for the name or property identified in the alert are recorded within the Dodge County Register of Deeds office. When an alert is triggered, an email will be sent to the email address provided in the alert. The email will contain more information about the activity and will have a link to LandShark, our county on-line property records system.

How much does it cost? Nothing. There is no cost to the user.

How do I sign up? There is a link to Land Notification placed on the Dodge County Register of Deeds office webpage where you can sign up.

DID YOU RECEIVE YOUR LOTTERY & GAMING CREDIT??

If you do not have a Lottery & Gaming credit on your tax bill you may still be eligible.

To Qualify: You must own a home in Wisconsin

Your home must have been occupied as a

PRIMARY resident on January 1, 2020. a. A primary residence is the home in which a property owner lives for more than six months of the year.

b. If temporarily away, a primary residence is the home to which the owner returns.

If you feel you qualify for the credit, and there is not a lottery credit on your tax bill, please plan to come to the Town Hall on one of the collection days to get the adjustment made.
